Directions to Rochester General Hospital

From the North, take 390 N to 590 N, exit at 104 West, proceed towards Goodman/Portland Avenue exit. Exit and continue to Portland Avenue by going across Goodman. Turn right onto Portland. Rochester General Hospital is on the right. Park in the Portland Parking Garage to the right of the hospital.

From the South, take I-390 N to 590 N, exit at 104 West. Exit at Goodman/Portland Avenue and proceed to Portland Avenue by going across Goodman. Turn left onto Portland Avenue. Rochester General Hospital is on the right. Park in the Portland Parking Garage to the right of the hospital.

From the East, take I-90 W to exit 45. Take 490 to 590 N. Take 104 West and exit at Goodman/Portland Avenue and proceed to Portland Avenue by going across Goodman. Turn left onto Portland Avenue. Rochester General Hospital is on the right. Park in the Portland Parking Garage to the right of the hospital.

From the West, take I-90 East to exit 47. Take 490 East to Rochester. Exit onto 104 West and continue to Goodman/Portland Avenue Exit. Proceed to Portland Avenue by going across Goodman. Turn left onto Portland Avenue. Rochester General Hospital is on the right. Park in the Portland Parking Garage to the right of the hospital.
